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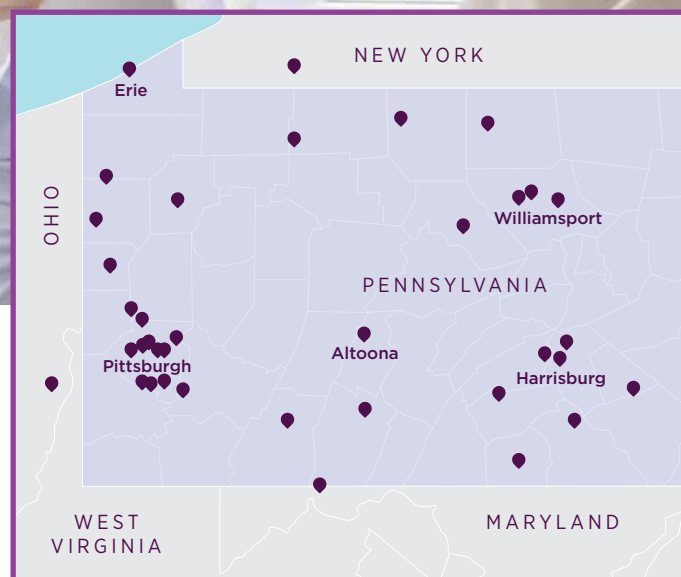

The FMEC expects nearly 1,000 attendees at the 2025 Annual Meeting, including 300 medical students, 250 residents, over 400 faculty and other post-training health professionals, 50 exhibit staff, and others. New To The Meeting?

Here are some tips!

- **Review the program:** Identify one or two sessions in each time block that especially appeal to you to help plan your schedule.
- **Use the tracks:** Many sessions are labeled with thematic tracks – residents and students should look for *R* and *S* respectively.
- **Use the mobile app:** Build your schedule for each day, and see who’s here to connect with.
- **Network:** This meeting is all about meeting people! Find others who share your interests and spend time in hallway conversations. Don’t be afraid to skip a session to chat with others.
- **Learn from the exhibits:** Meeting with the exhibitors will enrich your learning and enhance your overall experience.
- **Let us help you:** If you aren’t sure what to do or have questions, visit the FMEC staff at registration, or look for staff or members wearing Board or Host Committee ribbons – that means they’re here to help you!

Description of Presentation Formats

Workshops (1 hour)

Workshops are designed to transmit specific skills and are directed toward learning methodologies and strategies for approaching problems in teaching students, residents and faculty. The participants should be actively involved and should be able to acquire an understanding of various approaches to these problems.

Seminars (1 hour)

Seminars are designed to transmit specific knowledge in a given area and consist of a combination of formal presentations and group discussions.

Research and Quality Improvement (30 minutes each – or 2 per 1-hour block)

These presentations report rigorously-designed investigations or quality improvement activities and are followed by a moderated discussion.

Paper Presentations

(15 minutes each – or 4 per 1-hour block)

Paper presentations provide an opportunity to present to a wide audience about research, scholarship, curricular design, teaching programs, community service, and any other topic of interest related to family medicine. Both completed projects and those under development may be presented.

Lecture Discussions

(20 minutes each – or 3 per 1-hour block)

The Lecture Discussion format involves a 20-minute presentation to share information that relates to a clinical, educational or policy topic, report of a project and/or activity, or introduction of a policy issue, along with time for participant discussion.

Posters (70 minutes per session)

Scientific posters are presented on various topics of interest in family medicine, with authors available for discussion.

Clinical Success Stories and Speed Presentations (5-7 minutes each)

This format provides the presenter 5-7 minutes and a maximum of 5 slides to share ideas and information in a focused, direct manner, followed by discussion. They are typically grouped with 4–10 in an hour-long session.

Clinical Camp Tables (70 minutes per session)

This format is an opportunity to watch and participate in a hands-on demonstration of a clinical procedure commonly performed in family medicine, using patient models and materials.

Breakfast Table Discussions (60 minutes)

Breakfast Table Discussions are opportunities during the Saturday breakfast for scholarly and networking discussions. The title of the table is the topic, and presenters may provide brief opening remarks but generally facilitate discussion of the topic.

Gary Lewis LeRoy, MD, DABFM, FAAFP

“Why This, Why Now, Why Us?: The Art of Noticing Unnoticed Wisdom.”

Dr. LeRoy is the Senior Vice President for Diplomate Engagement of the American Board of Family Medicine and an associate professor of Family Medicine at Wright State University Boonshoft School of Medicine. He is a board-certified family physician, providing comprehensive medical care at Community Health Centers of Greater Dayton. Dr. LeRoy is a native Daytonian, received his undergraduate (1982) and MD (1988) degrees from Wright State University and completed his residency at Miami Valley Hospital. He completed a fellowship at Michigan State University in 1992. Dr. LeRoy is the Past-President and Board Chair of the American Academy of Family Physicians. He is also an active member of the Ohio State Medical Association, the American Medical Association, the Ohio Academy of Family Physicians (Past President, Educator and Philanthropist of the Year awards), and the Phi Rho Sigma Medical Society 2 (Vice President). He has served on the boards of the Dayton Levitt Pavilion, East End Community Center, WestCare Ohio, and The Dayton Contemporary Dance Company, and The Dayton Foundation.

Christine Alexander-Rager, MD, FAAFP

“My Backstage Pass to the Corner Office: How Family Medicine Ushered Me into Health System Leadership.”

Dr. Alexander has been a physician with the MetroHealth System since 1997 and was named the institution's President and Chief Executive Officer in October 2024. She enjoys a legacy of leadership positions in the health system including the Interim Chief Clinical Officer, Chair of the Department of Family Medicine, President of the Medical Staff, President of the Council of Chairs, Director of Maternal and Newborn Health, Residency Program Director, and Case Western Reserve University Family Medicine Clerkship Director. She was the founder of MetroHealth's School Health Program and served as its Medical Director from its inception until 2017. Dr. Alexander has devoted her career to serving those who struggle with access to care through family system, cultural, language or financial barriers. Through her leadership, the Department of Family Medicine created not only school health but correctional medicine, healthcare for the homeless, integrated behavioral health and expanded services for PRIDE patients. Dr. Alexander has been involved in the FMEC as a three-time Chair of the Host Committee, Planning Committee Chair, Board of Trustees member and Board President. She has been the recipient of numerous local and national awards for program innovation, clinical care and teaching.

Louito Edje, MD, MHPE, FAAFP, SrADME

“You Can't Spell AIR Without AI: How Artificial Intelligence is Essential for Living, Working, and Learning in Medicine.”

Dr. Edje is a board-certified family physician, chair of the family medicine review committee of the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education, former chair of the nominating committee of the American Medical Association's Council on Medical Education and a member of its executive committee. She was the Ohio Academy of Family Physicians 2012 Family Physician of The Year and received two Distinguished Humanitarian awards in 2022 for community work with vaccine hesitant patients during the COVID pandemic. She was president of her class at the University of Michigan Medical School (UMMS) then completed her family medicine training, with honors. This was followed by 13 years in private practice and health system leadership including service as department chair, chief of staff, and credentials chair. During her pivot into academia, she attended the National Institution of Program Director Development (NIPDD) and obtained a masters in health professions education. She is an emeritus designated institutional official of the National Association of Designated Institutional Officials (NADIO). She has the privilege of leading the medical education mission of the University of Michigan. As senior associate dean for medical education, she supports the medical education of 780 medical students, 1,300 residents and fellows, and 3,500 faculty.

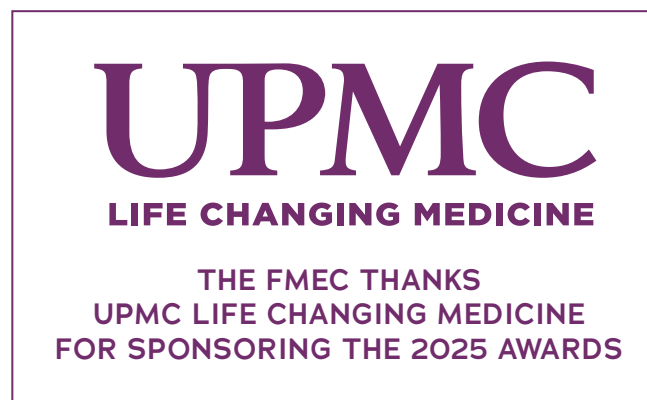

About the FMEC

The Family Medicine Education Consortium (www.fmec.net) is a catalyst, convener, and incubator that connects those interested in improving health by strengthening family medicine/primary care services and medical education. The FMEC mission is to improve the health of the nation by strengthening family medicine and primary care to meet its full potential. The FMEC is a non-profit organization incorporated in Ohio (FEIN 31-1436038).



The FMEC serves 14 states and the District of Columbia in the northeastern U.S., from New England to Virginia and west to Ohio. FMEC's constituency in these states includes nearly 60 Medical School Departments of Family Medicine and over 220 family medicine residency programs accepting about 1,300 first year residents annually. The FMEC region graduates over 9,600 medical students, with about one-quarter from osteopathic medical schools. Combined, the FMEC region is home to over 35,700 professional active family physicians.



FMEC offers Individual Memberships (\$50 for Residents and Fellows, \$100 for others) as well as Organizational and Academic Partnerships for health systems, departments of family medicine and family medicine residency programs (\$1,000 to \$25,000 and over). Over 90 institutions have joined the FMEC. The FMEC regularly communicates to over 5,000 individuals who are members, organizational partners, and past meeting attendees.

Outside the FMEC Annual Meeting, the FMEC convenes learning networks of residency programs on clinical and medical education topics. Volunteers engage with the FMEC to help develop collaborative and quality improvement programs, and to serve on FMEC committees and the Board of Trustees. 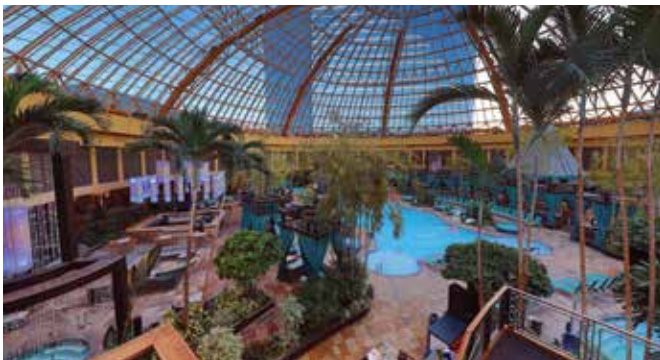

At the Convention Center
