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Programming/Initiatives Residency Fair

- Since 2006, 60-90 residency programs from northeast U.S. participate each year
- Opportunity for medical students and program directors/faculty to meet
- 2 hours each day Friday and Saturday
- Fees are \$680-\$980, increase after Early Bird deadline
 - Why the range? FMEC Partners get \$300 discount
 - Includes booth plus FREE resident registration
 - Director/faculty member must also register (additional)

Programming/Initiatives Residency Fair – Fee Details

2023 Residency Fair Booth Fees

- Residency Fair Display Booth, \$680 \$1,030 (variable)
 - Early Bird Rates end August 11: Partner: \$680 | Non-Partner \$980
 - Regular Registration Rates, August 12 September 8: Partner: \$730 | Non-Partner \$1,030
 - Booth registration deadline is September 8 No on-site booth registrations
 - Includes free Resident registration \$400 value



Programming/Initiatives

Family Medicine Residency Showcase*


- Virtual meetings/webinars held August-October
- In 2022, 13 sessions presented by 9 unique health systems, with over 500 individuals registering
- Goals
 - Provide medical students (all years) the opportunity to learn about the breadth and depth of family medicine
 - Help residency programs highlight themselves and their strengths
- Fees
 - \$600 per session, \$300 if you have a Residency Fair booth
- Duties
 - Program: sign up, provide topic and speakers, confirm date
 - FMEC: market the event, set up Zoom meeting, handle registration, moderate, post and market the recording

Programming/Initiatives Student Scholarships



- Nearly 7,700 students since 1994
- 300 students each year
- 45-55 schools participate
