Partner Levels and Benefits

Dues are collected on an annual basis, based on join date.

Bronze - \$1,000, one entity

Bronze level does not include individual FMEC memberships for residents and faculty.

- If your Family Medicine Residency or Department of Family Medicine joins at the Bronze level, the primary benefit is a \$300 discount off of the Residency Fair booth at our Annual Meeting, along with being recognized as a Bronze Partner on our website, social media, and emails.
- If your Medical School joins at the Bronze level, the FMEC will provide scholarships (\$500 value each) to students from your school who apply to come to our Annual Meeting. If 2 or more students come, the cost has been covered.

Silver - \$2,500, one entity

If your Family Medicine Residency or Department of Family Medicine joins at the Silver Level, the benefits include:

- \$300 discount off of the Residency Fair booth
- Recognition as a Silver Partner on the website, social media, emails
- Free individual FMEC memberships for *all your residents* (\$30 value each; you send us a list and we add them to our database)
- Free individual FMEC memberships for up to 10 of your faculty (\$75 value each; you send us a list and we add them to our database)
- Those residents and faculty get discounts on their Annual Meeting registrations as members (typically \$75 off)
- Your program gets invited to submit job postings or fellowship openings in our Special Edition newsletter, which goes out to our full region (14 states+DC) 5 or 6 times a year. Hiring/recruiting staff are usually our contacts for this and happy to be able to circulate open positions without individual fees each time (for the year of Partnership).

Gold - \$5,000, three entities

- Instead of up to 10 faculty, we'll give free memberships to all faculty (basically any staff you want to send to us)
- A free exhibit booth at our Annual Meeting (normally \$2,500), along with two registrations. Most Partners use their free exhibit booth to promote the health system and recruit.
- Opportunities to share info in our general email newsletter anytime you'd like.

Platinum - \$10,000-\$24,999, up to 5 entities

Joining at the Platinum Level makes your Family Medicine Residency/Department of Family Medicine a Partner, along with 4 more affiliated residency programs or medical schools. (See our <u>Partners List</u> for examples of how we list multiple entities). Each entity will be listed as a Platinum Partner on the FMEC website, in social media, and in emails. In addition, each individual residency program and medical school affiliated with the system, up to 5, will receive specific and individual benefits. These include:

- A \$300 discount off of their Residency Fair booths (each booth up to \$1,500 off!) for the FMEC Annual Meeting
- Free individual FMEC memberships for *all residents* (\$30 value each; you send us a list and we add them to our database)
- Free individual FMEC memberships for *all faculty* (\$75 value each; you send us a list and we add them to our database)
- As FMEC members, those residents and faculty will get discounts on their Annual Meeting registrations (typically \$75 off).
- A free exhibit booth at our Annual Meeting (normally \$2,500), along with two registrations. Most Partners use their free exhibit booth to promote the health system and recruit.
- Recognition from FMEC leadership during a plenary session at the FMEC Annual Meeting.

President - \$25,000, which includes any/all affiliated medical schools and residency programs

The health system, hospital or university that joins the FMEC as a President Level Partner (\$25,000 or higher) will be able to include all their affiliated residency programs as FMEC Partners. They will receive all the benefits listed above, as well as a sponsorship credit for a major event or activity at the FMEC Annual Meeting, to be determined (President Level Partners are often recognized as supporting a plenary session).

All the benefits and recognition above last for a one-year term based on the Partner's anniversary date with the FMEC and will continue as long as the Partner renews. Each year, we will work with you to update your lists of faculty and residents who receive the free memberships and discounts.

Guide to Joining the FMEC

Bronze Level (\$1,000) If you are an individual family medicine residency (FMR) and plan to participate in the FMEC Residency Fair and/or the FMEC initiatives to support meeting ACGME requirements, join at the Bronze (\$1,000) Level.

If you are a **medical school** and your students want to attend the FMEC Annual Meeting on FMEC scholarships, join at the Bronze (\$1,000) Level. (As of 2022, the requirement for medical schools to be partners for their students to receive scholarships is being enforced.)

Silver Level (\$2,500) If your residents and faculty attend and/or present at the FMEC Annual Meeting, join at the Silver (\$2,500) or Gold (\$5,000) Levels, so they receive individual FMEC memberships and get discounts on meeting registrations.

If you need to advertise jobs and fellowships to 5,000+ health care providers throughout the northeast, join at the Silver (\$2,500) Level or higher.

Gold Level (\$5,000) If your system has mutiple FMRs who want to participate with FMEC, join at the Gold (\$5,000) Level or higher to enroll your FMRs as Bronze Partners.

If you want to get exposure throughout the northeast and at the Annual Meeting as a leader in family medicine, and promote your faculty and their accomplishments through the FMEC, join at the Gold (\$5,000) Level or higher to be featured in FMEC communications and at the Annual Meeting.
